Directions

The Bach Dancing & Dynamite Society is located in The Douglas Beach House, 311 Mirada Road, Half Moon Bay, on the corner of Mirada Road and Cortez. There is a wooden sign in the middle of the building by the steps. There is limited parking behind the building.



Directions from the Peninsula (San Mateo area) Highway 280 or 101:

- Take Highway 92 West to Hwy. 1 in Half Moon Bay.
- Go north (right) on Hwy. 1 for 2.5 miles.
- Turn left on Medio.
- Turn right on Mirada.

Important . . . DO NOT TAKE MIRADA ROAD OFF HIGHWAY 1. It does not go through to the Beach House due to footbridge.



From San Francisco:

- From 280 South, take Hwy. 1 exit toward Pacifica.
- Continue south on Hwy. 1 through Pacifica, the Tom Lantos tunnel, and the small towns of Montara and Moss Beach.
- Once you get to the light at Capistrano Rd at Princeton Harbor there will be one more light and then watch for the Miramar sign.
- Turn right on Magellan.
- Turn left on Mirada.

To avoid traffic from the Peninsula, we recommend that you either come before noon and enjoy the coastside before the concert, or plan your drive so that you are at the reservoir on Hwy. 92 around 3:30, which should leave time to arrive at the Bach Society before the music starts at 4:30. Going back after the concert is usually not a problem.
