



COVID-19 Safety Protocols

All patrons, staff and artists must be vaccinated against COVID-19.

Boosters are highly recommended but not required. Safety protocols and requirements for entry are subject to change. Please check our website on the day of the performance for the safety protocols and requirements in effect on that day.

Patron requirements:

Vaccination Requirements and Proof and Valid ID-Ticketholders are required to provide a valid government issued photo ID and proof of full* vaccination upon entering the Bach Dancing & Dynamite Society ("the Bach"). The Bach accepts the following vaccination records:

- Original CDC vaccination card or photo of original card with all fields visible
- California or other digital COVID-19 Vaccine Record that includes name, birthdate, manufacturer, and dosage dates, in addition to the QR code.

Name and birthdate on ID and vaccination record must match. No refunds or credits if proper ID and vaccination record are not provided at the door.

*Full vaccination - This is defined as completion of the two-dose regimen of Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, one dose of Johnson & Johnson vaccine, or other World Health Organization (WHO) authorized COVID-19 vaccines administered two weeks or more in advance of the concert. Contact us in advance of purchasing tickets to verify acceptable proof of any WHO authorized vaccines other than Pfizer, Moderna or Johnson & Johnson at customerservice@bachddsoc.org

Minors - Minors under 18 years old may attend if fully vaccinated and may show student ID card, birth certificate or passport in lieu of government issued photo ID and for minors under 12 an ID is not required as long as they are accompanied by fully vaccinated parents/guardians. Vaccine proof required is the same as for adults.

Masks – Currently masks are required. In the interest of the continued safety of our patrons, staff and artists, we require patrons and staff to wear masks, unless actively eating or drinking. All staff will continue to wear masks. On the stage, musicians have the choice to wear or not wear masks.

Other - Please follow all posted guidelines and onsite signage, as well as any verbal instructions from staff and volunteers.

Door Procedures:

Prior to entering the venue, please have ID and vaccination record ready to present. After verifying your vaccination status we will check you in for the concert from our door list and provide your wrist band with seat number. Printed or digital tickets are not required. Once the concert room opens, volunteer ushers are available to help you find your seats.

Additional Safety Protocols:

Ventilation – Doors and windows will be open for maximum ventilation. including operable skylights in the west side of the concert room. Air purifiers and fans are utilized as needed also.

Public restrooms – Equipped with touchless fixtures.

Disinfecting – Occupied areas are cleaned and sanitized between events.

Supplies – Masks, hand sanitizer, and disinfecting wipes are available by request.

COVID-19 Pandemic Liability Limitation:

In purchasing tickets for an in-person concert at the Bach Dancing & Dynamite Society (Bach), you attest that you, and each person you purchased a ticket for, acknowledge the contagious nature of the Coronavirus/COVID-19 and that the CDC and other public health authorities may recommend masks, social distancing, and/or full vaccinations for indoor events.

You further acknowledge that the Bach has implemented preventative measures to reduce the spread of the Coronavirus/COVID-19, however even with these measures, you further acknowledge that the Bach cannot guarantee that you will not become infected with the Coronavirus/COVID-19. You understand that the risk of becoming exposed to and/or infected by the Coronavirus/COVID-19 may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of yourself and others, including, but not limited to Bach employees, contractors, volunteers and other participants.

You voluntarily seek to participate in the activities run by the Bach and acknowledge that you are increasing your risk to exposure. You acknowledge that you must comply with all set procedures to reduce the spread while participating.

For the holder of each ticket you purchased, you attest that: You and all ticket holders agree to comply with our COVID-19 Safety Protocols located on our website.

You hereby release and agree to hold the Bach harmless from and waive on behalf of yourself, your heirs, and any personal representatives any and all causes of action, claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses and compensation for damage or loss to yourself, your child, and/or property that may be caused by any act, or failure to act of the organization, or that may otherwise arise in any way in connection with any services received from the Bach. You understand that this release discharges the Bach from any liability or claim that you, your heirs, or any personal representatives may have against the organization with respect to any bodily injury, illness, death, medical treatment, or property damage that may arise from, or in connection to, any activities provided by the Bach. This liability waiver and release extends to the organization together with all directors, employees, contractors and volunteers.

This acknowledgement and waiver applies equally to the holders of all tickets purchased by you. It is your responsibility to ensure that each individual reads and agrees to the terms of this waiver prior to requesting and purchasing tickets for a Bach in-person event.
